

- We only reserve primitive sites for groups of 30 or more, otherwise they are first come, first served. Major holidays excluded.
- · Online reservations are available through Reserve America.
- Electric and Water site reservations require a 2-night minimum stay (March-September).
- All camping and Electric & Water fees are collected at the time of reservation
- Some major holidays require a 3-night minimum stay. Holiday rates apply.
- There is a \$15 cancellation fee per site and \$50 for the cottage.
- There is a \$10 rescheduling fee.
- All cancellations/reschedules must be done at least 48 hours prior to your arrival date.
- Cancellations made less than 48 hours prior to arrival date will forfeit the first night's camp fee(s) and electric & water fee(s).
 The remaining balance, if any, will be refunded.
